

The History of C3

2008

From April to October, 2 teams of 7 men and 3 cars each travelled half way across Canada. Team West began in BC, Team East from PEI, stopping along the way to spread the gospel. The two teams converged in Georgetown ON where over 150 Christians gathered from all over North America for a grand finale week of evangelism.

2010

After a year long hiatus, some of the brethren felt a real need for this work to continue in Ontario. This time, the team consisted of 5 young men and 1 couple and 2 classic cars which travelled around Ontario proclaiming the gospel, from May until August.

2011

Looking to the Lord for guidance and looking back on the blessing of last year's trip, the brothers responsible for C3 feel that it is the Lords will to continue the work this year. This May through August, C3 is hoping to focus on southern ON. The team has not fully formed yet, and the schedule is still open for any assembly that would like to have the team come.



Cross Canada Cruisers is for young men with a passion for God, a heart to see sinners come to know the Saviour, a willingness to take orders, a thirst to know God's Word, a loving attitude toward their fellow workers and an ability to "endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ".

Cross Canada Cruisers is for assemblies that have been in prayer about how they should spread the good news, feel C3 would be an answer to those prayers and are willing to do the preparation necessary for a full week of evangelism. This would mean co-labouring with the team in whatever form of witnessing the assembly decides to do, and do the follow-up work of Bible studies and counselling after the team leaves.

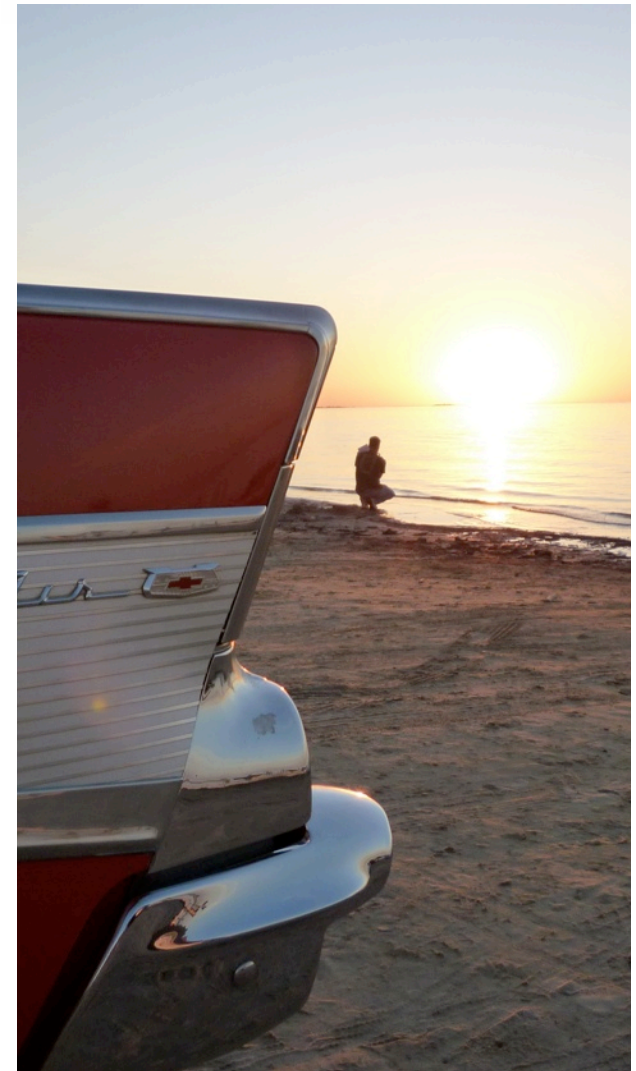

3 Part Mission of C3

1. The Cross

The gospel is the mission of Cross Canada Cruisers (C3).

2. The Canadian assemblies

In Ephesians 4 we read how the Lord has sent evangelists “to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ” (ESV). Noticing the need for this kind of ministry, C3 desires to work with assemblies so that they will be equipped for the ministry of evangelism. There is a 12 week planning chart at teamc3.info that can help you plan for a successful week of outreach.

3. The Cruisers

C3 is a discipleship program for young men (the Cruisers) that want to make their lives count for eternity. This is not a Caribbean cruise; it will be hard work and demand all your time. The hours of travel, evangelism, prayer and studying the scriptures will be tiresome. We feel this needs to be an extreme commitment because anything less would unworthy of the One who said “If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me.”

(Matt. 16:24)

What a Typical Week Looks Like

Monday-Friday

The team rolls into town Monday and meets the assembly. The guys are then split up between host homes. Classes are held in the morning. In the afternoon the team does evangelism then has a time of prayer before supper. In the evenings the team can take part in an evangelistic event, like taking the cars to a local park or “Cruise Night” at an A&W.

Saturday

This is a great day for an event, like setting up at a local fair or having a car wash. Saturday events are a good opportunity for getting the whole assembly involved.

Sunday

The team is available to help with Sunday school, give an update, or take any ministry meetings.

This is not written in stone. C3 is flexible to work with whatever schedule best suits your assembly.

What Do You Have To Do?

Cross Canada Cruisers will help guide you through each step of the planning process which includes:

- **Deciding what form of evangelism you want to focus on**
- **Planning events**
- **Ordering gospel materials**
- **Planning accommodations for the team**
- **Providing meals, usually the host homes provide breakfast and different saints provide lunch and dinner at the chapel**
- **Making a plan for follow up, usually setting up a home Bible study for those contacted during the week**
